## Swimming at Serenity Estate

Serenity Estate has 215 feet of shoreline, one of the best water fronts on the lake. Located next to a bay adds privacy from boaters crossing the lake who must be further out to navigate around.

The rocks you see are landscape flat rocks tiered like steps. 4 steps down to the water from any part of the shore. Closer to the boat house the less steps.

The water is very swimmable, sandy bottom, very clean and clear for the first ~60 feet from shore. The shore line has sandy beach including a fire pit and there is a water volley ball net for all to enjoy.



For your outdoor water enjoyment, we provide (see pictures under lists):

- **2 docks**, 1 is 60 feet long, 6 feet wide with a 12 foot by 12 foot sitting area at the end for panoramic view of the lake
- 4 canoes, with easy carrying access to the water
- **2 peddle boats**, with easy electronic winch ramp to get in and out of the water. Each fits 4 people
- **2 Tandem Kayaks**, the most popular compact, lightweight tandem sit-on-top in the world. Stable and versatile, it can be paddled solo or tandem. Fits two adults plus a small child or pet
- **10 Muskoka Chairs**, durable and comfortable for time around the camp fire or on the dock relaxation, additional plastic lawn chairs are available




## Serenity Estate Swimming & Canoeing



The water has a gradual depth from 6 inches to 5 feet at the end of the dock, which is about 60 feet from shore.

The first 5 feet from shore is a mix of smooth stones and firm sand and the next 55 feet is firm sand.





An additional site for swimming is less than a 2 minute canoe ride into the bay where you will find a couple of <u>acres</u> of "Shallow Sandy" waters 1-2 to 3-4 feet deep.
